Participants: Conference participants include paper authors, discussants, and invited graduate students. A list of all participants appears in Table 1. (A few Northwestern faculty members also will be attending select sessions.)

Hotels: Conference participants who do not live in the Chicagoland area are staying at one of two hotels—Omni Orrington or Hilton Garden Inn. Both hotels are in Evanston, about five minutes from one another, and a five-to-10 minute walk to the campus conference locations. Table 1 includes hotel information for each out-of-town participant.

A folder with important conference information will be waiting for you at check-in. (Please ask for it if you do not receive it.) Name tags will be distributed on Thursday at the conference.

IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT GROUND TRANSPORTATION: Due to budget constraints, reimbursements are limited to *a total of* \$110 for ground transportation per participant. Thus, ride-sharing to and from airports is strongly encouraged. Details below.

Transportation from the Airport (upon arrival): There are three options for getting to Evanston. We recommend using one of the options below as City of Chicago taxis—which are available outside of the baggage claim area—often have trouble navigating to, from, and around Evanston. If, however, you do opt to take a Chicago taxi, please note that the cost from O'Hare to Evanston should not exceed \$40. (Some drivers may attempt to charge you 1-½ times the rate; this is incorrect, as Evanston is not a suburb that is subject to this fee.) The cost from Midway to Evanston should not exceed \$60.

Option 1: Order an Evanston taxi upon arrival. After you have collected your bags, call one of the cab companies listed below. They will tell you where to meet them (usually on the second median outside baggage claim). Cost: appx. \$33 from O'Hare and \$52 to Midway, plus tip—and the driver will know the route.

Option 2: Airport Express Shuttle. Shuttles depart from O'Hare every 10-15 minutes. Ticket counters and loading zones for boarding are at Door 1E, Door 2D, and Door 3F across from baggage claim. For more information, call 888.2THEVAN, or see: http://www.airportexpress.com/. It is cheaper but will take longer.

Option 3: From either airport, you take the "L" train (O'Hare is on the Blue Line, Midway is on the Orange Line) into downtown and transfer to Evanston. (See the CTA Website for more information on where to transfer.) During rush hour (6-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m.), the Purple Line runs express from Chicago to Evanston; otherwise, you take the Red Line north and transfer to

the Purple at Howard St. All transfer points are included in the single-ride fare. In Evanston, get off at the Davis St. stop. (You can ask an attendant for directions for the short walk to your hotel.) Schedules and fare information can be found at: <u>http://www.transitchicago.com</u>. This is the cheapest option (a few dollars) but will take the longest.

Transportation to the Airport (for departure): The hotels can contact a taxi (or shuttle) to take you to the airport. As with transportation from the airport, I strongly encourage you to coordinate with others to share taxis. Table 3 provides detailed information on everyone's plane departures, by hotel. Again, you will note that many of your departure times closely coincide. (Departure terminals will not matter as long as those sharing rides are leaving from the same airport.)

Ride-Sharing: Given the budget constraints for ground-travel reimbursement, please coordinate with other attendees to share rides. Table 2 provides detailed information on everyone's plane arrival, by terminal. Since many arrival times are very close together, we suggest contacting others in advance and meeting at a specific baggage claim location (e.g., baggage claim #5, terminal 1). Note that the hotels are close enough together that rides can be shared between people staying at different hotels. Please do not be shy in contacting people you have not previously met!

Travel by Train: Most trains arrive at Union Station in downtown Chicago. You can take a taxi, although a more efficient route given Chicago traffic, might be to walk across the street to the Ogilvie (Metra) Transportation Center at Union Station. The Union Pacific North Line is the Metra line for Evanston. Get off at the Davis St. station (Zone C), 901 Davis St., 847-492-5066. At that point, ask an attendant for directions to your hotel; it's about a five-minute walk to either hotel. Metra schedules can be found at: http://metrarail.com/Sched/cnw_n/cnwn.shtml.

Parking Information (local participants): Chicagoland participants who are driving need parking passes for on-campus parking. You can e-mail Samara Klar at <u>samaraklar@gmail.com</u> by **Saturday, May 23** with your address, and she will send two nonrefundable, visitor campus parking passes (one for each day). You can then park on campus in lots where visitor parking is allowed. Otherwise, you can park at the Church Street Self Park, 525 Church St., 847-328-4607. This garage is located on the east side of Chicago Avenue between Church and Clark streets. (Garage entrances are on either street.) Getting from the Hotels to the Conference: There will be a map in your folder detailing how to walk from either hotel to the campus, a pleasant 10-minute walk. On Thursday and Friday:

- There will be Northwestern graduate students leading two walking groups, one at 8:00 a.m. and another at 8:20 a.m. Meet in the hotel lobby.
- Shuttle service from the Hilton Garden Inn will also be available at 8:00 and 8:20 a.m.
- Car rides from the Omni will be provided by two Northwestern graduate students at 8:00 a.m. (Toby Bolsen) and 8:20 a.m. (Brian Falb). Meet in the hotel lobby.

Getting from the Conference to the Hotels: At the end of Thursday's session and at the end of dinner on Friday, Northwestern graduate students will be on hand to help participants get from the conference to the Omni (either walking or by car). The Hilton hotel shuttle also will run.

Thursday Night Dinner: Prairie Moon Restaurant, 502 Sherman Ave., Evanston, 847-864-8328 The buffet dinner will start at 6:00 p.m. Thursday's program is slated to end at 5:15 p.m. The restaurant is a 10-to-15-minute walk from either hotel in the opposite direction from the campus (i.e., traveling from campus to the restaurant entails going past the hotels). As mentioned, graduate students will facilitate transportation back from the conference to the hotels; they also will be available at the hotels at 5:45 p.m. to guide people to the restaurant. They will be available after dinner to ensure everyone gets back to the hotels.

Friday Night Dinner: Norris Student Center, 1999 Campus Dr., Wildcat and Big Ten Rooms The buffet dinner will start at 6:00 p.m. Friday's program is slated to end at 5:45 p.m. We will walk directly from the last session to dinner at Norris, a short five-minute walk. Graduate students will facilitate transportation back to the hotels after dinner.

We will also e-mail you these instructions and the NetID ahead of time. Given the large number of computer configurations, we will not be able to help participants individually configure their laptops once on campus.

Panel Format

Here are the details on how panels will proceed:

- Authors will NOT present their papers. The discussant will instead summarize them.
- Specifically, discussants will:
 - Summarize each paper.
 - Offer suggestions of missing literature.
 - Evaluate each paper's strengths and weaknesses, and offer constructive advice.
 - Suggest connections between papers (and identify areas of repetition).
 - Reflect on the general research area.
- One of the book's editors will serve as a moderator for each panel. The moderator will introduce the panel, keep time, and oversee the subsequent discussion. The moderator also will offer some suggestions about how the authors might better adhere to the specific guidelines sent.
- We aim to allow at least 30 minutes for subsequent open discussions. Discussions will begin with each author having a *brief* opportunity to comment, followed by the open discussion.
- Discussants may, if they have time, provide written rough comments to the authors.
- The final conference panel will be a general open discussion, moderated by Don Kinder.

Discussant Presentations: Discussants should e-mail their presentations (Powerpoint or pdf formats) in advance to Eric Betzold at <u>betzold@northwestern.edu</u> by Wednesday, May 27 at noon. If this is not possible, please bring it on a flash drive. If you have other needs, however, please contact Eric by the above-stated deadline. (This includes needing to use a Mac and using presentations with advanced audio or video features.)

Papers: See <u>http://faculty.wcas.northwestern.edu/~jnd260/experimentation/</u> to download papers. A very small number of printed papers will be available at the conference (thus do not plan on picking them up there). We will assume that all authors on each panel have read the other papers for their particular panel. We hope that many (or some!) of the conference participants will glance at papers from other panels as well.

Mentor Program: Each graduate student has been paired with one faculty member for each day of the conference. Faculty members have a match for at least one of the two days, and, in some cases, both days. Matches are in Tables 4 and 5. The matched pair will have lunch on the given day to discuss mutual research interests and other professional issues. Prior to the conference, graduate students should e-mail a *brief* bio-sketch to their mentors and a CV (if available) by Monday, May 25.

Matched pairs are of course free to merge with other pairs. Unmatched faculty can join other groups or enjoy lunch with other unmatched faculty. If anyone has difficulty locating their match, contact me at the start of lunch. (Lunch on Thursday will take place at the Allen Center. On Friday, box lunches will be provided, and they can be eaten anywhere on campus.)
