TRANS 310: NOTES ON PAPER FORMAT

Paper Structure

- 1. Title Page with
 - a. Paper title
 - b. Your name
 - c. Class (TRANS 310)
 - d. Date
- 2. Abstract a one-paragraph non-technical description of what your paper is about and what the main findings are.
- 3. Main body of the Report
 - a. Introduction set out what the problem statement is
 - b. Literature review
 - c. Data sources (for paper 2)
 - d. Analysis
 - e. Discussion of findings
 - f. Conclusions
- 4. Acknowledgements (if any) people who helped you
- 5. References

Considerations for the Main Body of the Report

- Use section headings (and section numbers) to break up the text
- Avoid writing in the first person
- Use footnotes sparingly
- Use 1.5 line spacing
- Use size 12 type
- 1" margins on all sides
- Page numbers
- Proof read and grammar check

Referencing
